Missoula Refugee Update thru February 23, 2018

During the last week of January 7 refugees were settled in Missoula and in February and additional 11 have arrived, all from Eritrea. The totals since August of 2016 are:

Democratic Republic of Congo	37
Eritrea	82
Ethiopia	7
Iraq	12
Syria	13

These numbers represent the people who were originally resettled in Missoula. We know that a number have left the area for a variety of reasons but at this point we are unable to get reliable data on the number of refugees who remain in Montana. It is also pretty close to impossible to find out how these people are faring with regard to employment and housing. It is interesting to note that the refugees that have arrived in the past several months have been overwhelmingly from Eritrea. It is not unusual for a VOLAG such as the IRC in Missoula to cluster refugees in a location so that they begin to have a "community" within the community. These refugees have escaped terrible conditions in their country that we can barely imagine and we wish them well.

A Tribute to George Washington *by Gary K. Carlson*



George Washington's birthday is actually February 22nd. But, as the "Father of our Country", it is only fitting that his birth be emphasized each year on Presidents' Day. This is as it should be, for we should pay tribute to the leadership and foresight he demonstrated in establishing our country.

Most everyone knows that George Washington was our first president, in addition to other familiar information about him (some true and some legendary). The more familiar information would include that he lived at Mount Vernon, had wooden teeth, never told a lie, cut down a cherry tree, was married to Martha, and was General of the Continental Army when we defeated the British in the Revolutionary War.

However, there is much more to know about our first president. He grew up in a family with three brothers and two sisters. He went to school until the age of 14 or 15. Washington's family believed in hard work, public service and in worshiping God. His family name, "Washington" goes back to 1260 in England and was "de Wessington." He was an expert dancer. He wrote poetry, and he enjoyed hunting, fishing and boating. He had a modest upbringing. His family's proudest possessions were one soup spoon, eighteen small spoons, seven tea spoons, a watch, and a sword. His father died when he was eleven. (Faith & Freedom by Hart, P. 229)

Washington's mother was dedicated to raising her son, George, as a committed Christian. She admonished him before he left home as a young soldier saying, "Remember that God is our only sure trust, my son." She added, "Neglect not the duty of secret prayer." George was a diligent and earnest reader of the scriptures, which he always kept near his bed at night. (Faith & Freedom by Hart, P. 229)

At age 21 Washington began his public service and was commissioned by the Governor of Virginia to explore, as a surveyor, the forks of the Ohio River (now Pittsburgh). Later he was appointed to the rank of major and then to LtCol in the Virginia militia. By age 22 he was appointed to Colonel and then Commander-in-Chief of all Virginia military forces.

In 1775 British General Braddock requested Washington, as a militia officer, to accompany him to dislodge the French from Fort Duquesne (by Pittsburgh). One thousand warriors came from all over to aid the French. Of the 1,459 British soldiers, 977 were killed including Braddock. Washington became a hero. An Indian shot at him 15 feet away. Fourteen bullets shot through his coat, and two horses were shot out from under him. Miraculously, he was unscathed. He then went for help and rode 40 miles to get reinforcements. The forest was so dense that at times he had to crawl on his hands and knees to find a path (Faith & Freedom by Hart, P. 232). The Indian Chief who fought on the side of the French was quoted later as saying, "The Great Spirit protects that man, and guides his destinies. He will become chief of nations, and a people yet unborn will hail him the founder of a mighty nation." (Ref: Faith & Freedom by Hart, P. 235)

Washington took command of the Continental Army in 1775 when he was 43. He was 6 feet 3 inches tall, weighed 220 pounds and arrived on a white horse. Such a leader was just what the colonists needed. (Ref: Faith & Freedom by Hart, P. 22)

He was not at the signing of the Declaration of Independence because he was with the troops. He spent six years with them including the brutal winter at Valley Forge. On Christmas, 1776 Washington led the troops to victory after crossing the Delaware River. They defeated the British and the Hessians. In the historic painting depicting crossing the river, John Adams sits behind Washington holding the American Flag. Trenton was a great victory for the Continental Army. One week later, Washington and his men crossed the Delaware River again and defeated the British at Princeton. Finally, on Oct 19, 1781, British General Cornwallis surrendered to Washington and his troops at Yorktown.

After the Revolutionary War, Washington presided over the Continental Congress. In 1787 the U.S. Constitution was written and ratified. In the first Electoral College, Washington received all 69 votes. He is the only president to have been elected unanimously by the Electoral College. The first Vice-President was John Adams. Washington did not belong to any political party. He served two terms and established an unofficial policy for two terms as president. Limiting the president to two terms became law after the 22nd Amendment was passed.

When the Continental Congress met in Philadelphia in 1787 to revise the failed Articles of Confederation, General Washington was the logical and unanimous choice to chair the convention. The new Constitution was established and ratified. It was primarily a new document of government "thou shall nots."

- Government shall not prohibit the free exercise of religion and expression.
- Government shall not take away people's guns.
- Government shall not arbitrarily seize property.
- Government shall not enter people's homes without just cause.
- Government shall not deny the accused a trial without a jury of his or her peers. All that government is permitted to do is defend the nation against external and internal threats to the life, liberty and property of America's law-biding citizens. Every convention delegate had a thorough understanding of the governments limited role. (Faith & Freedom by Hart, Page 326)

The most important person in this convention was George Washington. As chair he would not take part in the debates, but his presence and demeanor were factors in the final passage. "Be assured," wrote James Monroe in a letter to Thomas Jefferson, who was still in France, "Washington's influence carried this government." (Faith & Freedom by Hart, P. 333) If Washington had one passion that outweighed all others, it was his love for our country. This love was punctuated by a sacred obligation to duty. A testimony to Washington's character and patriotism is evident in the following quotes:

- *"A good moral character is the first essential of a man; The power, under the Constitution, will always be in the people; I was summoned by my Country, whose voice I can never hear but with veneration and love; I can say I had rather be at Mount Vernon with a friend or two about me, than to be attended at the Seat of Government by the Officers of State and the Representatives of every Power in Europe. "*

Dinesh D'Souza has had a 25-year career as a writer, scholar, and public intellectual. A former policy analyst in the Reagan White House, D'Souza also served as John M. Olin Fellow at the American Enterprise Institute, and the Robert and Karen Rishwain Fellow at the Hoover Institution at Stanford University. He served as the president of The King's College

in New York City from 2010 to 2012. Called one of the "top young public-policy makers in the country" by Investor's Business Daily, D'Souza quickly became known as a major influencer on public policy through his writings. His first book, *Illiberal Education* (1991), publicized the phenomenon of political correctness in America's colleges and universities and became a New York Times bestseller for 15 weeks. It has been listed as one of the most influential books of the 1990s.



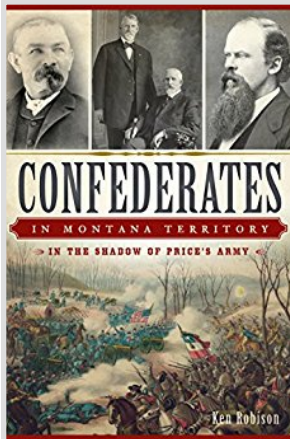

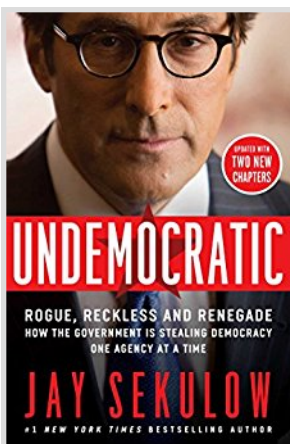
Books Worth Reading

We Cannot Defeat an Enemy We Don't Know or Understand



Review: You'll be fascinated to learn the role Confederates played in the founding of the Last Best Place. The Last Chance Gulch gold discovery, found by two Confederates from Georgia. Lewis & Clark County, home of our state capital, Helena was originally named Edgerton County, after Sidney Edgerton, Mr. Edgerton was named Montana's first territorial Governor. The Montana legislature, upset with the Governor over his treatment of a duly elected legislator who was a Confederate, who the Governor forbid from presenting any bills, changed the name to Lewis & Clark County and did it in the middle of the night. Sounds a little like Helena City Council removing a Confederate statue.

Excerpt: "Nearly seventy Democratic lawmakers refused to attend Trump's inauguration, an unprecedented violation of democratic etiquette that would have provoked massive media outrage had Republicans done it to, say, Bill Clinton or Barack Obama. And just weeks into his presidency, even before Trump had done anything that could remotely be considered unconstitutional, Democratic Congresswomen Maxine Waters and Tulsi Gabbard raised the issue of impeachment. Columnist Richard Cohen even suggested the need for a "constitutional coup"—basically an assembly of elected officials who, according to Cohen, have the authority to remove from office a president whom they deem "unable to discharge the powers and duties of his office."



Excerpt: "Let me be clear: if someone tells you our government is "gridlocked," they typically mean that they can't get everything they want. Because our government is anything but gridlocked. Consider this fact: from 2009 to the end of 2012, the federal government's bureaucracy created more than 13,000 new regulations—each with the binding force of law. 11 Even in 2012, one of the lowest rule making years of the last twenty (and the peak of the alleged "gridlock" in Washington, as President Obama battled a Republican House during a hotly contested election), the federal bureaucracy finalized 2,482 rules. 12 That's a staggering number of new laws. And not one American voted for any of the regulators who drafted, evaluated, and approved those new laws. Unelected regulators are now so powerful that Congress will often write laws that contain intentional gaps, allowing for regulators to come in and fill in the relevant details."

Send in the Clowns, a song immortalized by singer Joan Collins. In one of the verses near the end of the song, it reads, "Don't you love farce? My fault, I fear. I thought that you'd want what I want ... Sorry, my dear! And where are the clowns, Send in the clowns, Don't bother, they're here". Joan was singing the Stephen Sondheim song, written for the Broadway Musical, *A Little Night Music*.

Ironically, the song isn't about clowns at all. It's about a lady reflecting on the ironies and disappointments of her life. Of course, the clowns were never sent in during the play. But in these challenging times, the clowns are taking center stage in the circus that has become 21st-century media. The Clowns of the Left have arrived.

Consider an article from Donald McNeil of the New York Times, titled "Trump's 'Hostility' Toward Hispanics to Blame for Severity of Flu Epidemic." 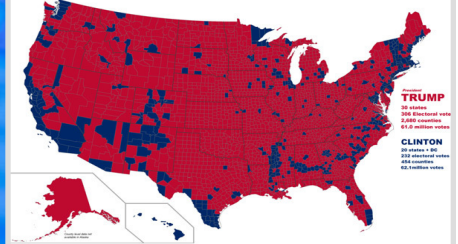

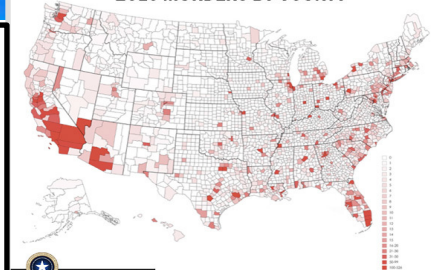

2016 ELECTION RESULTS BY COUNTY



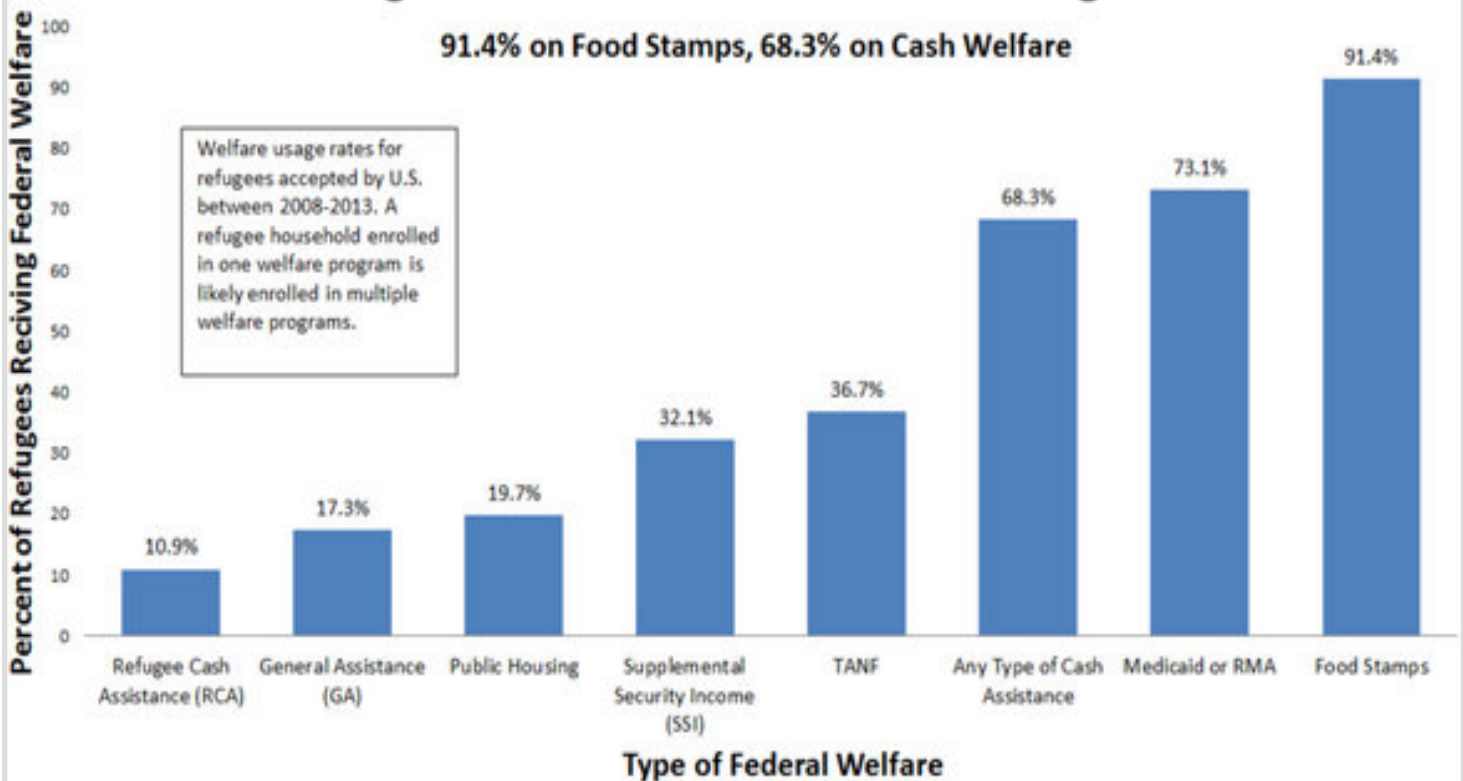
2016 MURDERS BY COUNTY

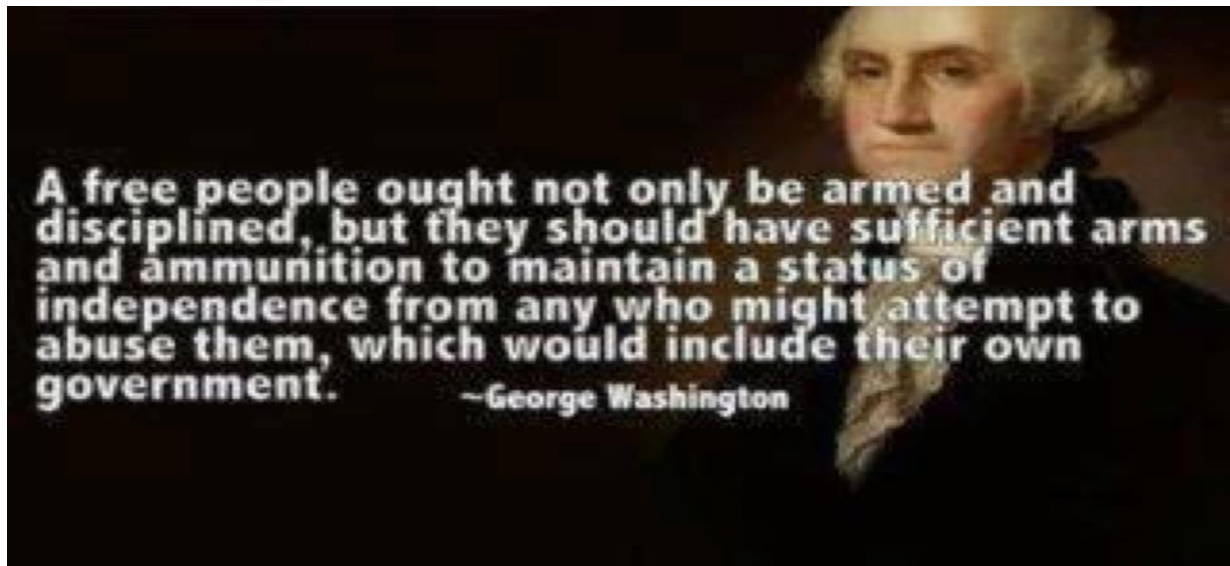
