Missoula Refugee Update thru June 20 , 2018

There have been 10 additional refugees resettled in Missoula between May 26th and June 20th: all are from the Democratic Republic of Congo. That brings the total number of refugees resettled in Missoula to 182.

In the next month, we will make a strong effort to find out if the IRC has plans to remain in Missoula and whether they are considering opening a second office in Montana. The IRC pocketed a tidy \$38,000 this month so it isn't a stretch to think that if they believed that another Montana city would be ready to open its welcoming arms to more refugees, they would happily open up another office. Our bet is on Helena, where the new mayor is excited about the possibility of fulfilling his commitment to further refugee resettlement in Montana. Wilmot Collins has a direct line to the UN and is likely campaigning for Helena to become another "welcoming" city.

The Governors Veto of Senate Bill 97 Will Haunt Us

In an article this week from the Gatestone Institute they reported that our neighbor to the north is experiencing the exact violation of law that Senate Bill 97 sought to prevent. That is the application of foreign law in our Courts. Here is an excerpt from their report.

"In 2015, a unanimous Supreme Court of Canada decision ruled that Saguenay, Quebec's city council could no longer open its meetings with a Catholic prayer stating that in doing so, those meetings infringed on freedom of conscience and religion. The court stated that religious neutrality: "requires that the state neither favor nor hinder any particular belief."

But apparently at Toronto City Hall, what's good for the Catholic goose doesn't apply to the Islamic gender because recently, according to The Quiggan Report, council chambers hosted a religious ceremony celebrating the breaking of the Ramadan fast.

Holding the prayer was the idea of Ward 42 councilor Neethan Shan in conjunction with Toronto Mayor John Tory, and that isn't the only incident that shows there seems to be a double standard applied when it comes to Islam.



Bullock said he was disturbed that the ban if he had signed it, could have been seen as an "endorsement for anti-Muslim sentiments and activity." He went on to say, "There is absolutely no need for this bill," Bullock wrote in his veto message, adding that the proposal could add to the "nationwide surge in hate crimes."

Gov. Steve Bullock vetoed a bill that would have banned Sharia and other foreign laws from being




used in Montana courts, saying Thursday that the measure would "upend our legal system and debase what we stand for as Montanans and Americans." According to an NBC Poll, 93% of Montanans didn't agree. As the Governor entertains fantasies of becoming President, he hangs Montanans out to dry. Who do he and his blood brother Big Jon represent? Helena Mayor Wilmot Collins Making the



Due to the cancelation of the Upper Klamath Basin Comprehensive Agreement last year, the city's [sic] well is now included in tribal calls on water, subjecting the city to shutoff notices issued by the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD). The Tribes, as the senior water right

holder in the Klamath Basin, made a call on water March 8 due to low water levels after an unusually dry winter. Severe drought conditions are forecast for this summer, and many water users are concerned about the impact of the Tribes' call."


