Missoula Refugee Update thru May 25 , 2018

Missoula welcomed 12 additional refugees during May: 6 from the DRC and 6 from Eritrea. This brings the total number of refugees resettled in Missoula since summer 2016 to 172. So far is has not been possible to find out the

number of refugees that actually remain in Missoula, or in Montana for that matter because that data is closely protected by the State Department and by the State of Montana. The fact is that the only way to track the refugees' locations after their first ninety days in the US is by tracking their use of public financial assistance programs and that information is highly protected. We know that some have left the area and some have left the state, seeking to move to areas that can provide better housing and employment opportunities or areas where relatives, friends or simply others from their home country are already settled. From the perspective of the refugees this is quite understandable. From the perspective of the International Rescue Committee it is of no consequence. The IRC has pocketed \$3800 per refugee from US government (\$4000 less \$200 cash they must demonstrate as having spent and \$800 of

donated goods they must have given) for a total of \$653,600 in Missoula! And remember the IRC has no responsibility for the refugees after 90 days! Yet, they still beg for money.

The Helena Independent Record reported that a Capital High School student was removed from class after posting a Snapchat video with a pistol in it. Keep that in mind, the post had a pistol in it. Helena Public Schools Superintendent, Jack Copps, said the district received a report from a student who saw the video and administrators have since reviewed it. Here are the key words from the man in charge: Copps said, "The video does not threaten anyone, but instead asks questions about the merits of gun ownership."


He went on to say, "That video simply questioned from a Second Amendment perspective whether a person was automatically guilty because they owned a firearm," Yet, he is the same Superintendent who led the charge for the young man's suspension. Speaking of Big Sky, right down the road a couple of hours in the Peoples Republic of Missoula we have Big Sky High School where a student was suspended and removed for wearing, of all things, a T-shirt with a rebel flag on it. The Missoulian reported that at Big Sky, student Mitchell Ballas said Wednesday he was wearing the sweatshirt to stand up for students' First Amendment rights to freedom of speech after one of his friends was asked not to wear a Confederate flag hat. And then the Left reared its ugly head.

Attorney for the Missoula County Public Schools, Elizabeth Kaleva promptly said, "There are a lot of cases actually where the use of the Confederate flag has been banned at schools and been upheld". Then of

course the Missoulian contacted the Montana Human Rights Council who reported that from the middle of 2016 to the end of 2017, the network counted "a tenfold increase in all hate incidents over the same period in previous years," Those reports include displays of the Confederate flag "for provocation." 

The Biggest Gator in Montana's Swamps' Gotta' Go



A Book that Matters ... to All Montanans

We featured this book last month as one of our three 'Books That Matter'. We do not know the Author nor have any financial or other interest in the book. However, it is the most important book any Montanan could read in this election year. It is a first hand education by a man who has experienced our government at its worst. Christopher Kortlander is a tried and true Montanan who is still standing and fighting after our government nearly destroyed his life and his livelihood.



Christopher Kortlander, the Author of *Arrow to the Heart*, is the Owner and Curator for the Custer Battlefield Museum in Garryowen, MT. It is located in the middle of the Crow Agency. He moved to Montana from California, bought the town of Garryowen and rebuilt it and developed the museum. The book is about the many injustices taking place today and one of the most important to Montanans with the upcoming elections this fall is the election of Jon Tester when he ran against Conrad Burns and surprised the nation by winning a very close election. There were rumors and even a lawsuit at the time regarding election fraud on the Crow Agency.

An entire section of his book devoted to his firsthand knowledge of the voter fraud that took place during the election in 2006. It is believed that this type of voter fraud continues to take place in Montana and should be of great concern to us in 2018. Brian Schweitzer, who was Governor in 2006, was actually recorded during a

presentation to a conference of trial lawyers bragging about how he used his power to perpetuate the fraud. Of course, when called out for his statements, he claimed to have been "joking." The details provided in this book are amazing, up to and including Mr. Kortlander's description of checks he cashed for tribal members, drawn on Jon Tester's campaign fund account, that they said were in payment for their votes for Jon Tester.

The book also contains a detailed account of the vendetta that BLM agents and the US Attorney for Montana waged against Mr. Kortlander at his Museum. He returned home one day to find a fully armed SWAT team with military vehicles blocking the entrance to Garryowen. Stephen King couldn't write something as frightening as what happened next. Armed agents stormed his place, interrogated him for hours and for the next five years pursued him, all for the want of an alleged fake 7th Cavalry button that had been planted by the agents themselves!

Mr. Kortlander also includes a chapter about a doctor and his wife in rural Utah who the BLM pursued over allegations of scavenging bones and running a stolen artifacts ring. Again, the BLM had set them up, imbedded a confidential informant in their lives, and relentlessly badgered them, threatened them and took them to court. At one point their home was descended upon by a SWAT team with over 80 members! The doctor eventually took his own life and his family was left behind to suffer further intimidation by the ravenous BLM agents. An incredible story!

This book uses these incidents and others, Randy Weaver, whose wife was shot by federal agents as she held a baby, the Bundys, whose saga still continues, LaVoy Finnicum's death at the hands of federal agents, to explain in great detail how federal agencies have been granted excessive powers under the guise of "law enforcement." You need to read this book and share it with others. Patriots, you know that we live in difficult times, times never before seen since the founding of our country. Tidbits from Around the Last Best Place




